



Purpose: The Roser Visiting Artist Program was established to enrich the lives and education of students on all campuses at the University of Colorado in music, theatre and dance, fine arts and film studies, by funding visiting professional artists who have a demonstrated record of excellence and a commitment to working with students. This enrichment and interaction will be fostered by the Artists' collaboration in the creative process with students and faculty.

Evaluation Criteria: Proposals will be awarded to support artistically excellent visitors who will have a broad impact on the students.

Important Dates: Proposals are due on Thursday, November 13, 2008. Proposals delivered in person or mailed must be received at the Page Center Office, 1305 University Avenue, Boulder, CO 80302, on or before 5:00 p.m. on the deadline date. Applicants can expect to hear results within 12 weeks after the application deadline. All funded activities must take place during the academic year.

Exclusions: Roser Visiting Artist Program Grants will not support fundraising activities, deficit reduction, receptions, marketing or publicity expenses.
